

Sprüth Magers

Usually the gallery, founded in 1998 by Monika Sprüth and Philomene Magers, shows two to three exhibitions at the same time. But the major exhibition of American artist Sterling Ruby, which opens on Gallery Weekend, will take up all the rooms by itself. Ruby, who is also a fashion designer and launched his label S.R. STUDIO. LA. CA. last year which was presented at Paris Couture Week, will show several new works in his Berlin solo exhibition, including a series of monumental wall pieces that combine the artist's longtime preoccupation with textiles and assemblage with motifs from his "WIDW" paintings, also on view. Upstairs, a selection of Ruby's ceramic sculptures explore different geometries.
